REQUEST FOR BIDS

RIGHT-OF-WAY MOWING, BUSHHOGGING & DEBRIS MANAGEMENT SERVICES

The City of Washington is soliciting competitive bids from qualified contractors to provide **mowing, bushhogging, and debris management services** along designated City right-of-way areas and other City-owned properties.

SCOPE OF WORK

The selected contractor will be responsible for mowing and bushhogging designated areas, including:

- Approximately **36.95 miles right-of-way**.
- An average right-of-way width of approximately **30 feet, plus or minus**, as designated by the city.
- Approximately **12.6 fields/areas surrounding City lakes** requiring mowing and vegetation management.
- Areas associated with the city's **water, wastewater, and electrical utility lines**.
- Removal, mowing, and management of accumulated vegetation and mowing debris as directed by the city.
- Maintaining areas in a neat, safe, and reasonably maintained condition throughout the contract period.

Contractors are responsible for providing all necessary **labor, equipment, fuel, tools, and other materials** required to complete the work.

The city reserves the right to adjust the areas and scope of work as necessary based on field conditions and operational needs.

BID REQUIREMENTS

Bids should clearly identify the contractor's proposed pricing for the scope of work and include the contractor's name, business name, contact information, and any relevant experience with similar mowing, bushhogging, right-of-way, or utility corridor maintenance projects.

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The city may consider **qualifications, experience, availability, proposed pricing, and the contractor's ability to satisfactorily complete the work** when evaluating bids.
