Call for vote: Councilmen: Fisher – Yes, Hill – Yes, Gunter – No, Cullars – Yes, Anderson – Yes, Mahoney – Yes. 5 to 1. The budget has been approved.

Councilman Hill made the motion to adjourn, Cullars second.
