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NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The City of Washington has tentatively adopted a millage rate that will require an increase in property taxes of 3.61 percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearings on this tax increase to be held at the City Hall Council Chambers at 102 East Liberty Street, Washington, GA 30673.

- Hearing #1 will be held at 9:00 am at the above location on October 3, 2025
- Hearing #2 will be held at 6:00 pm at the above location on October 3, 2025
- Hearing #3 will be held at 9:00 am at the above location on October 10, 2025

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 8.320 mills, an increase of 0.290 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 8.030 mills.

The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$100,000 is approximately \$11.02, and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$23.20.
